## VERSATOOL PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS

- **P.** Tool is leaking from the tip.
- **S.** Remove the soil pipe and in the base of the valve tighten the seat gasket holder with a 5/32" hex wrench.
  - If tool continues to leak, remove the seat gasket holder with a 5/32" hex wrench and replace the (white) seat gasket.
  - If tool continues to leak, replace O-rings on the valve rod. Disassemble the trigger, then remove the seat gasket holder; push the Valve rod out from above.
- P. Leaking occurs around the soil pipe connection to the valve.
- **S.** Remove the soil pipe and in the base of the valve tighten the seat gasket holder with a 5/32" hex wrench.
  - If leak continues, remove the Seat gasket holder (5/32" hex wrench) and replace the white seat gasket.
- **P.** Leaking occurs around the rod spring at the center of the valve handle.
- S. Replace O-rings on the Valve rod.

  Disassemble the trigger, then
  remove the Seat gasket holder;
  push the valve rod out from above.
